MATERIALS ACCEPTED



GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS. Rinse. Remove lids (metal lids can be recycled, but must be unattached). Paper labels okay. *No plate glass, drinking glasses, cookware, light bulbs, ceramics, etc.*



PLASTIC CONTAINERS: Rinse. **ONLY** bottles, jars, pails, clam shell (hinged) containers, tubs such as for cottage cheese, sour cream, etc.) Snap-on lids okay; no screw on lids. *No automotive chemical or pesticide bottles. No microwave trays, party platters, plastic wrap or bags, Styro-foam, or items marked "compostable." No plastic toys, yard items, clothes baskets, molded plastics, plastic cups, clothes hangers, etc.*



ALUMINUM & STEEL (TIN) CANS: Rinse. Don't flatten. Metal lids okay. Labels okay. **EMPTY** aerosol cans okay. Foil and pie plates okay, but must be flat, *not* balled up.



NEWSPAPERS: Includes inserts. *Do not place in plastic bags or secure with string.*



MAGAZINES & CATALOGS: *No glue bindings more than 1/2 inch thick.*



JUNK MAIL: Open and remove non-recyclable items.



OFFICE PAPER: White paper (letterhead, typing, copier, index); computer paper (white, blue & green bar); colored paper (pastels only; *no neons or deep tones*); envelopes (windows okay); coated paper (fax, glossy brochures, ads; staples okay; *no plastic-coated papers such as some ream wrappers*); file folders (manila or pastel).



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD & BROWN PAPER BAGS: Flatten boxes. *No wax-coated boxes.*
